FELLOWSHIPS, SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS 2023 NEW RESIDENTS

We offer a range of scholarships and bursaries to support our residential community. It's an important way for us to give back and helps adds value to the culture and community of our College.

WHAT IS A SCHOLARSHIP OR BURSARY?

Scholarships are generally merit-based, while bursaries* are needs-based. Some are awarded for the duration of university studies, while others are awarded for one year only. We only offer financial support to residents who intend to live with us for the full academic year.

You can only hold one scholarship at a time, usually the one of highest value. All scholarships are applied to your Accommodation Fees per semester at the relevant pro-rata value.

THRIVE SCHOLARSHIPS

THRIVE FELLOWSHIP

\$6,720 or \$3,360 subsidy for a duration determined by the Head of College. Up to 5 awarded per annum.

THRIVE Fellowships are available to new applicants only. You must be a Domestic (Australian) or International student enrolled at any WA University, to be eligible. The Fellowship is valued at \$6,720 or \$3,360 annually. The total value awarded will depend on the competitive nature of your application, which is assessed by the Head of College.

Fellowships may be awarded for a single year, or for the duration of study, at the discretion of the Head of College.

ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA

To be eligible for a THRIVE Fellowship the applicant must have achieved excellence or elite performance (nominally at a national or equivalent level) in one or more of the following areas:

- academic studies;
- leadership;
- music or creative arts;
- sport;
- civic engagement and contribution.

You must also meet one of the following criteria:

- Have experienced specific hardship, disadvantage or circumstance that is likely to be a significant barrier to their university aspirations, or
- Are first-generation Australian citizens and/or are the first-generation in their families to be enrolled at university, or
- Come from an educational, cultural, or geographic background that is underrepresented in undergraduate or graduate study, in their discipline, at their university.

Returning THRIVE Fellowship awardees are expected to mentor incoming scholarship recipients. You will also be expected to demonstrate outstanding levels of engagement in College life, solid academic achievement and continued elite performance in your field of excellence to maintain the Fellowship which is renewed annually.

^{*}Bursaries are confidential arrangements between the resident and the Head of College and will not be publicly recognised.

Should the resident break their Full Year Accommodation Contract and leave early, the scholarship, bursary or discount must be paid back to the College in full within 14 business days.

THRIVE AWARD

\$1,960 to \$3,080 subsidy for one year only. Up to 20 awarded per annum.

THRIVE Awards are available to new applicants only. You must be a Domestic (Australian) or International Student who is enrolled at any WA University, to be eligible. Each Award is worth up to \$3,080 for your first year at the College.

ELIGIBLITY CRITERIA

To qualify for a THRIVE Award, you are required to demonstrate a high level of commitment to your studies with appropriate progress and achievement. You must also demonstrate contribution to your school, university, or the wider community. A letter of recommendation from your school must be included in your application.

For example, consideration will be given to:

- Experience in leadership roles.
- Participation and contribution to charitable or service activities or groups, or to environmental or sustainability projects.
- Membership & contribution to sporting or other community groups. Includes roles in coaching, umpiring & mentoring.
- Involvement and contribution in debating, music (instrument, vocal, solo or group), composing, drama, dance
 or other performance groups, visual arts and crafts, design, film making, directing, and writing.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

BACHELOR OF PHILOSOPHY THRIVE SCHOLARSHIP

\$6,720 subsidy for new residents with an ATAR of 99 to 99.9. \$3,360 subsidy for new residents with an ATAR of 98 to 98.95.

Bachelor of Philosophy THRIVE Scholarships are available to students enrolled in The University of Western Australia's Bachelor of Philosophy program. This scholarship is tenable for the normal duration of an undergraduate degree course. It is conditional upon your academic progress and community engagement meeting the expectations of the College.

Returning awardees are expected to mentor incoming scholarship recipients. To retain your scholarship in subsequent years a WAM of 80 will be expected to be maintained.

FOGARTY THRIVE SCHOLARSHIP

\$3,080 subsidy for one year only.

Fogarty THRIVE Scholarships are available to students who have been awarded an UWA Fogarty Foundation Scholarship This scholarship is tenable for the normal duration of an undergraduate degree course. It is conditional upon your academic progress and community engagement meeting the expectations of the College.

Returning Fogarty scholarship awardees are expected to mentor incoming awardees. To retain your scholarship in subsequent years a WAM of 80 will be expected to be maintained.

HACKETT THRIVE SCHOLARSHIP

\$3,080 subsidy for one year only.

Hackett THRIVE Scholarships are available to recipients of The University of Western Australia's Hackett Scholarship. This scholarship is awarded in the first year of residence only.

ADA PURNELL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

\$1,960¹ or \$3,080² subsidy for one year only. Up to 5 awarded per annum.

New residents who are beginning full-time, first year studies at any WA university and have achieved an ATAR (or equivalent) of 97.0 or greater are eligible for Ada Purnell Academic Scholarships. This scholarship is awarded in the first year of residence only and a letter of recommendation from the school must accompany the application.

- 1. For domestic students from metropolitan areas and international students, the scholarship has a value of \$1,960.
- 2. For domestic students from interstate or regional, rural, and remote Western Australia, the scholarship has a value of \$3,080.

ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL SUPPORT

TRINITY RESIDENTIAL COLLEGE HEAD OF COLLEGE BURSARY

Trinity Residential College has a small number of bursaries available to provide financial assistance to prospective or current residents who desire to live at the College but may not be in a financial position to do so. These bursaries are awarded at the discretion of the Head of College.

Any resident seeking financial assistance should arrange an interview with the Head of College. During the interview you must demonstrate attributes of effort and engagement and will need to be able to provide evidence of financial need.

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

We will offer you a **discount of \$670** if your sibling is either a current or former resident of the College. This discount cannot be used in conjunction with any other scholarship or bursary. So, if you're awarded one of our other scholarships, you aren't eligible for the sibling discount too.

You don't need to apply for this, it will be automatically awarded as a credit to your account as long as you let us know of this during your interview or upon arrival at the College.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications for a Trinity Residential College Fellowship, Scholarship and/or Award can be made via our website.

You must submit your application before 1 January 2023. Late applications will be accepted in exceptional circumstances at the discretion of the Head of College.

You'll need to include the following information in your application:

- A personal statement in support of your application. This statement should address the criteria of the Fellowship, Scholarship and/or Award you are applying for.
- A copy of your most recent School Report, University Entrance results and University Results (if applicable).
- A letter of recommendation from a School Principal, senior staff member or community leader.
- The name and contact details of a referee.
- Any other supporting documentation with you feel is relevant to your application.

And don't forget, you can only apply for a scholarship, bursary, or discount if you intend to live with us for the full academic year.

Applications will open on 1 September 2022 and close on 1 January 2023.
